Hike the Towering Red Dunes of Sossusvlei

Venture on foot into the vast Sossusvlei clay pan and scale its towering red dunes to admire the austere, otherworldly beauty of this striking terrain. Crest a dune to take in the monochrome sand sea that lies beyond, stretching endlessly out toward a distant horizon.

Gain Unique Insight to Himba Traditions

The Himba are a semi-nomadic people who still follow many of their centuries-old traditions. During a stay in the remote Kunene region, and if the Himba are in the area, you'll have the rare opportunity of visiting a community to learn about their customs and age-old traditions.

Behold the Shipwrecks of the Skeleton Coast

Twyfelfontein is Namibia's only UNESCO World Heritage site and is one of the country's most highly prized treasures. These are some of the best-preserved prehistoric etchings on the planet and as you wander around the site with a local expert, you will observe up to 2,500 distinctive rock carvings and paintings, some estimated to be around 6,000 years old.

Stargaze in Africa's Only International Dark Sky Reserve

Stand in Awe of the Ruins of Jerash


